I am directed to state that the Post Graduate Committee of this Council at its meeting held on 10th & 11th March, 2014 considered the assessment report (July, 2013) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Bangalore Medical College and Research Institute, Bangalore for Recognition of M.Ch.(Paediatric Surgery) qualification against increased intake from 01 to 03 seats granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore and it was decided as under: -

"The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (July, 2013) and decided to recommend not to recognize M.Ch.(Paediatric Surgery) qualification against increased intake from 01(One) to 03(Three) seats granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore in respect of students being trained at Bangalore Medical College and Research Institute, Bangalore because of the followings:-

1. Inadequate clinical material.
2. Workload for 3 PG students is inadequate as only 500 surgeries are performed in a year. Major surgeries have decreased from 898 in 2010 to 507 in 2012.
3. Total beds in the department 18 only.
4. Average daily OPD is only 25 - 30.
5. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report."

You are requested to rectify the above deficiencies at the earliest and submit the compliance for further consideration in the matter.

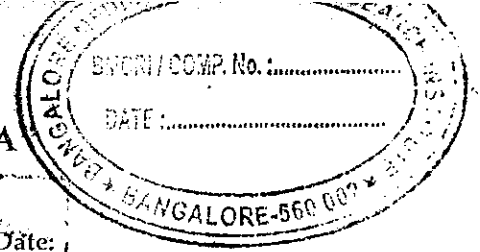
